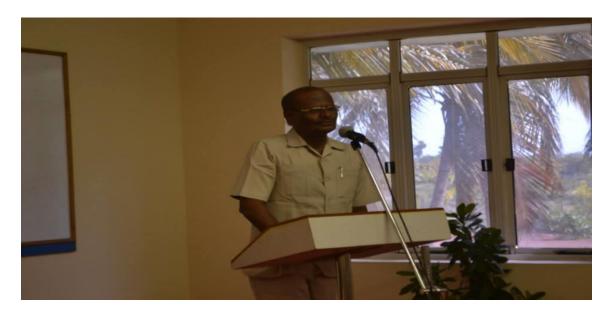




### Constitutional Day
